**WHEREAS,** The State of Texas, On the 27 day of July in the

until he pays you cause to be made the aforesaid sum  
of 1.25 Dollars, fine imposed as aforesaid, and also, the said further sum  
of 20 Dollars, costs, as aforesaid, together with the costs of this execu-  
tion, and your legal fees accruing in said matter.

**HEREIN FAIL NOT,** But make due return of this execution to our said District Court, on or before the  
first day of the next term thereof, with your return thereon endorsed how you have executed the same.
