

Weather Preparedness Check List

Get your construction site ready for rain events!

Heavy rainfall can increase the risk for erosion, sediment discharge, localized flooding and stormwater pollution. Preparing before rainfall events helps to avoid environmental and safety concerns and protects our local waterways and stormwater systems.

Before the storm:

- ☐ Inspect erosion and sediment controls for proper installation and maintenance
- ☐ Remove accumulated sediment from BMPs where needed
- ☐ Stabilize exposed soils and inactive disturbed areas
- ☐ Ensure construction entrances and tracking controls are functioning properly
- ☐ Secure stockpiles, waste materials, and loose debris

After the storm:

- ☐ Inspect disturbed areas for erosion or sediment migration
- ☐ Repair damaged BMPs as soon as possible
- ☐ Remove sediment tracked onto roadways
- ☐ Document maintenance and inspection activities as required

NOTE: Stormwater controls should be maintained in accordance with project plans and applicable permit and SWP3 requirements.
