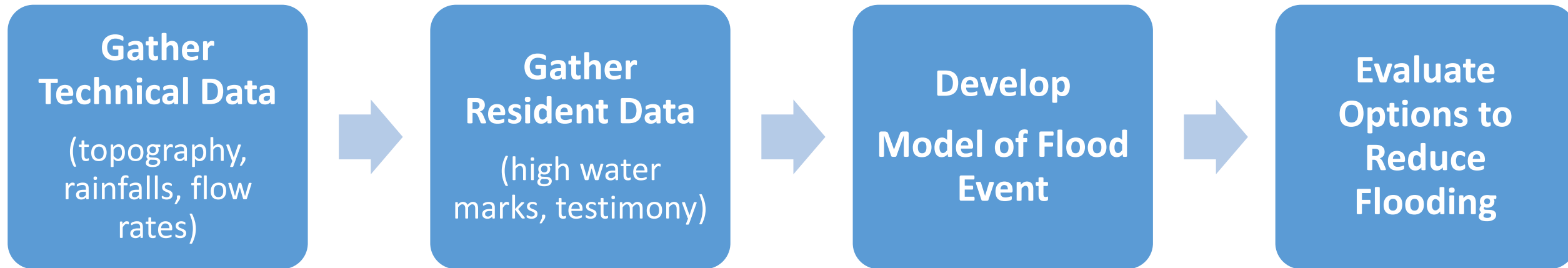
Study Purpose

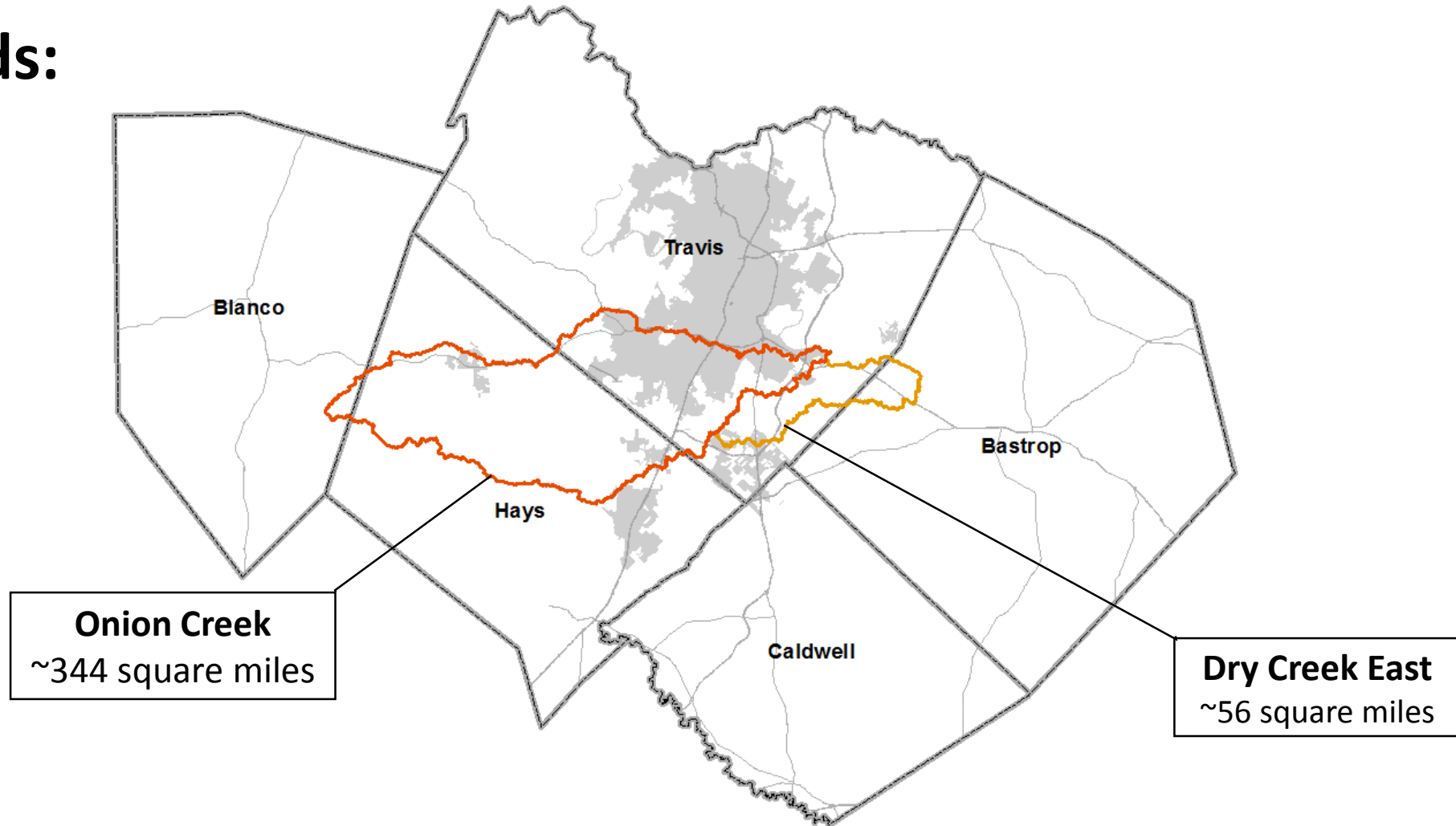

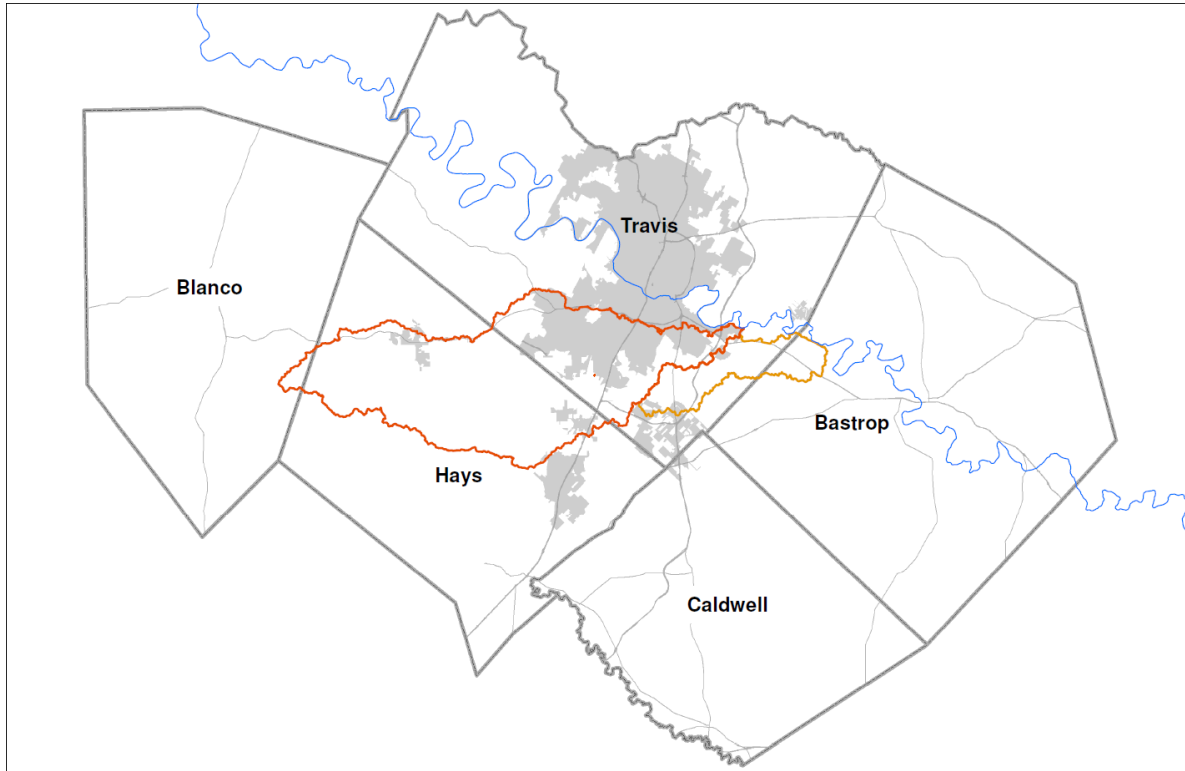

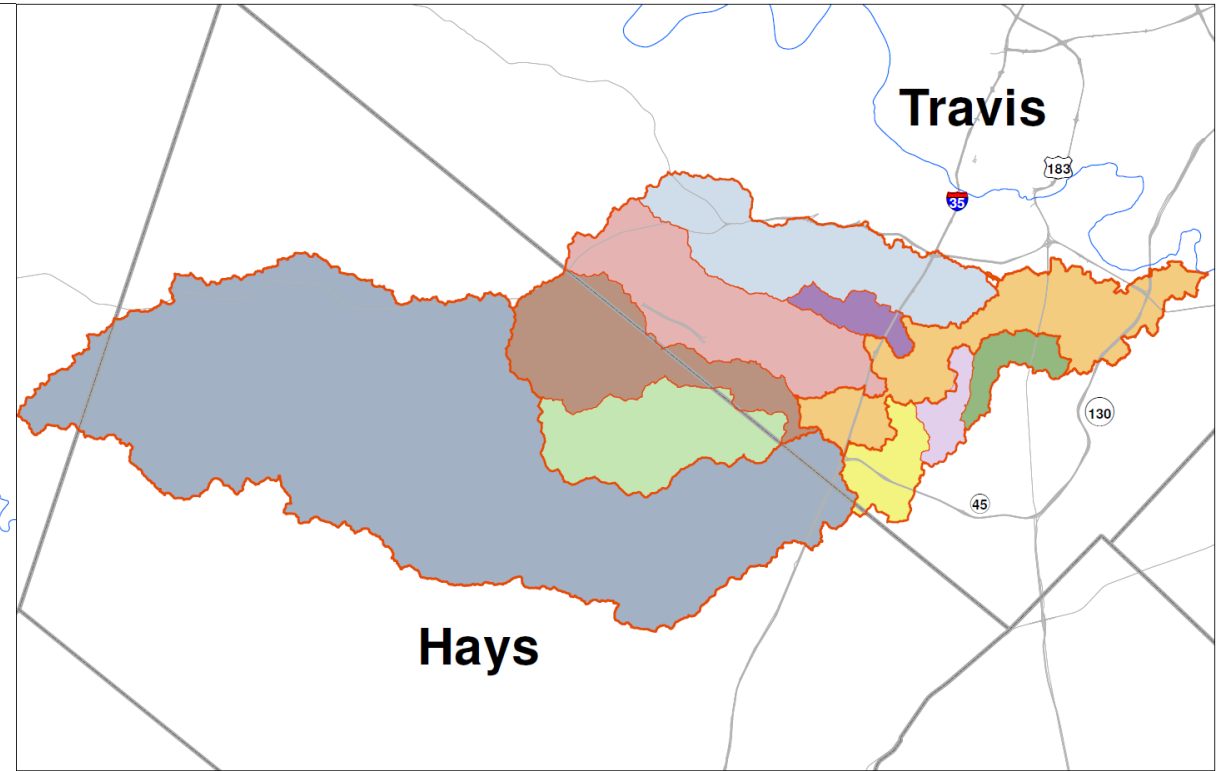




Watershed or Sub-watershed?



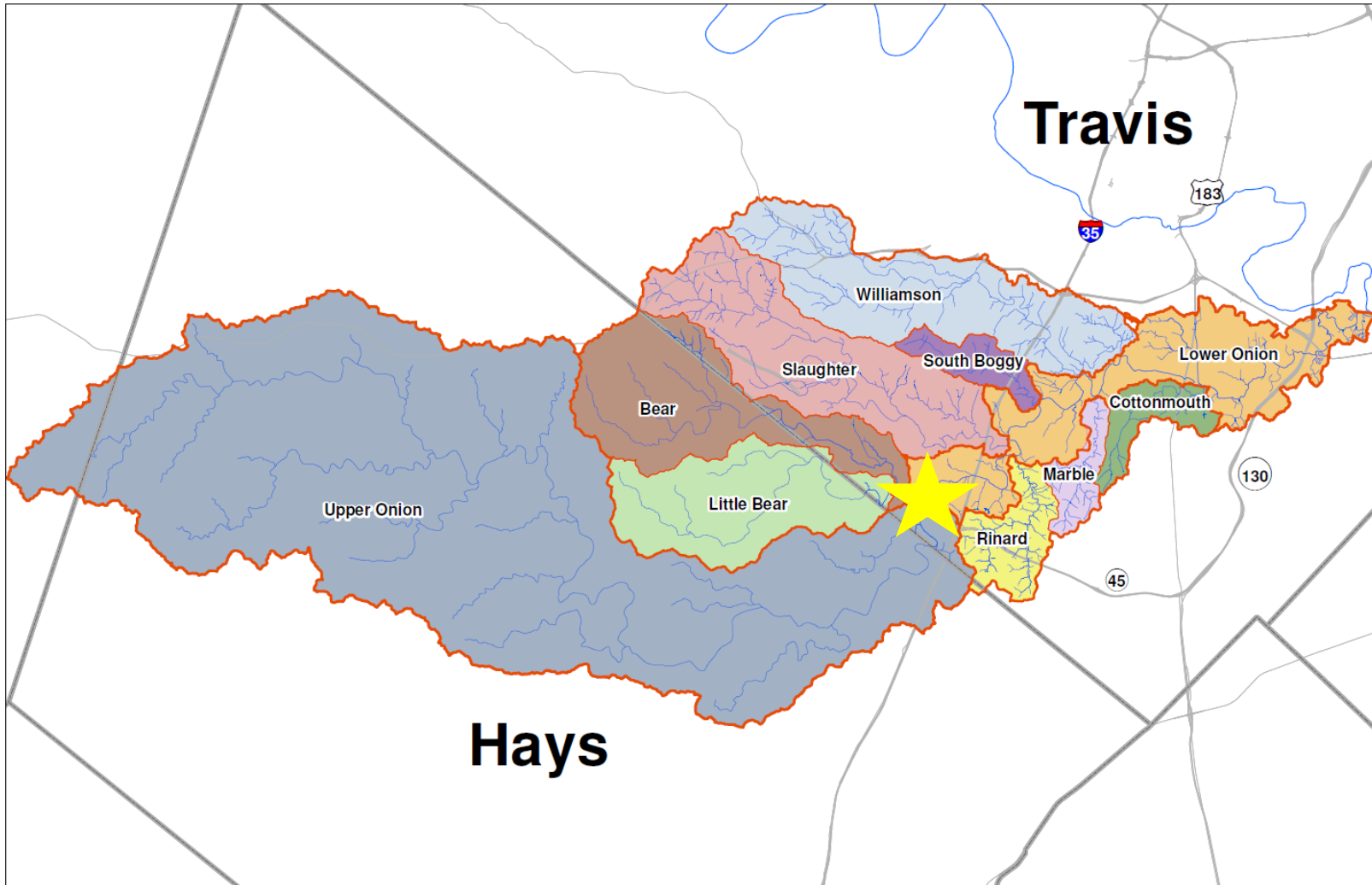
Watershed: An area of land that drains to a common location



Subwatershed: smaller portion of a larger watershed



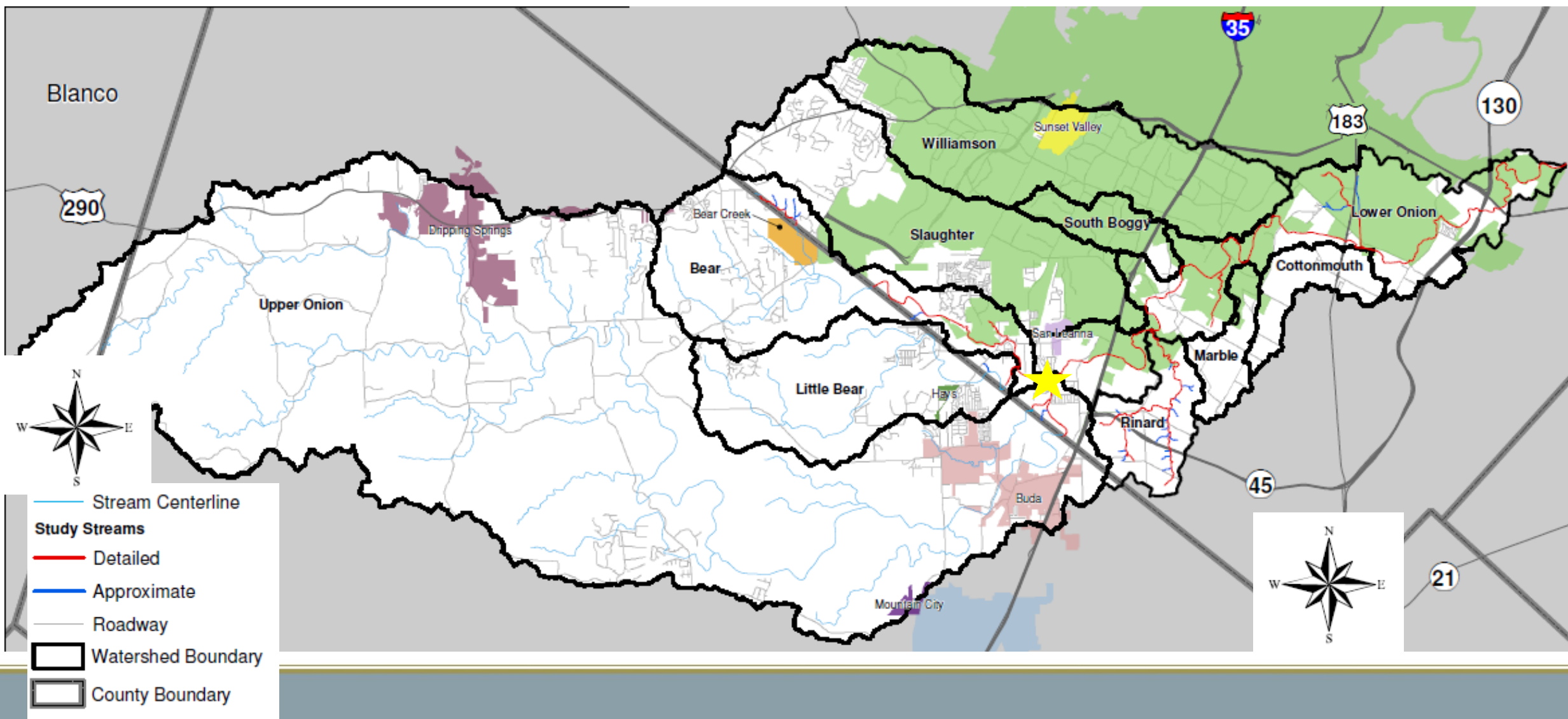

9. Lower Onion

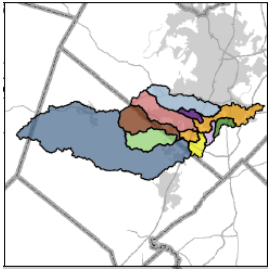

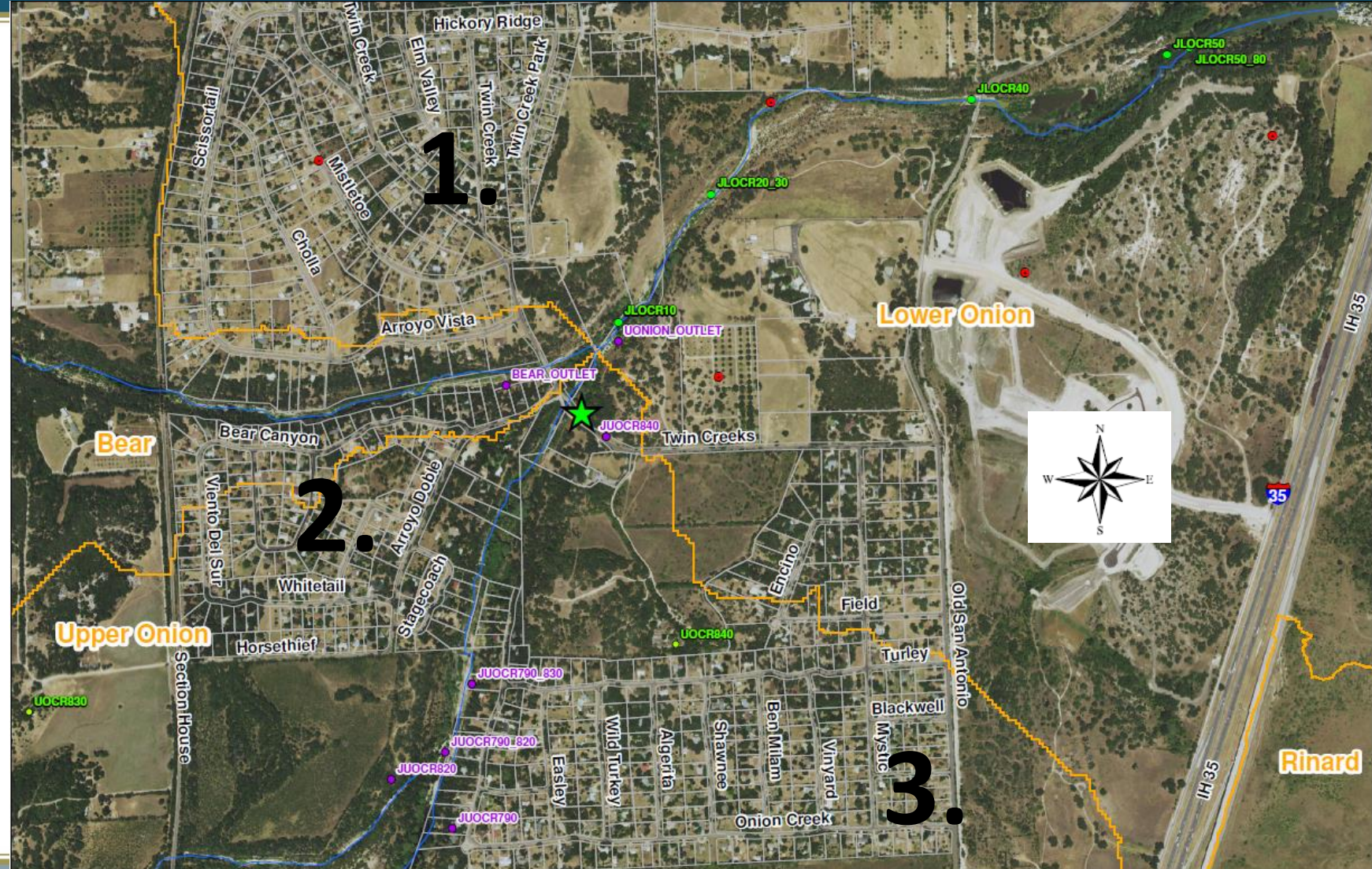

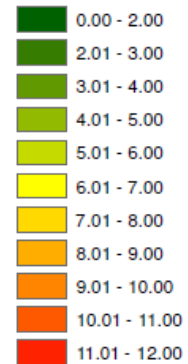


Onion Creek Rainfall

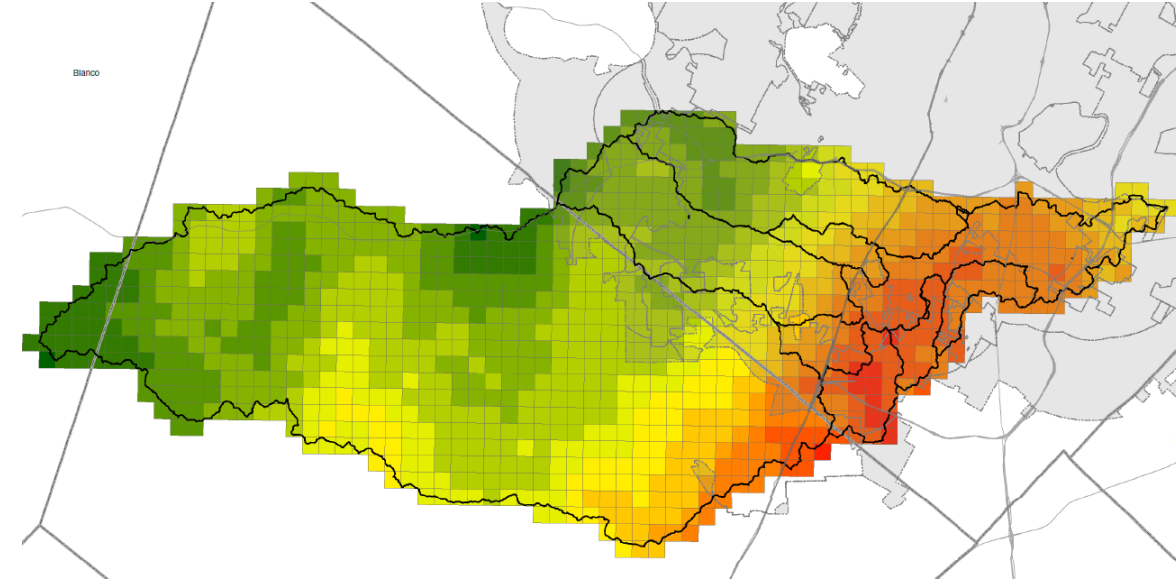
October 2013



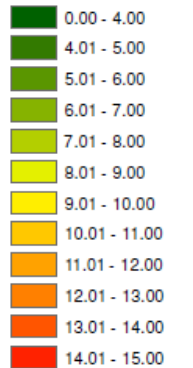
Rainfall (inches)



October 2015

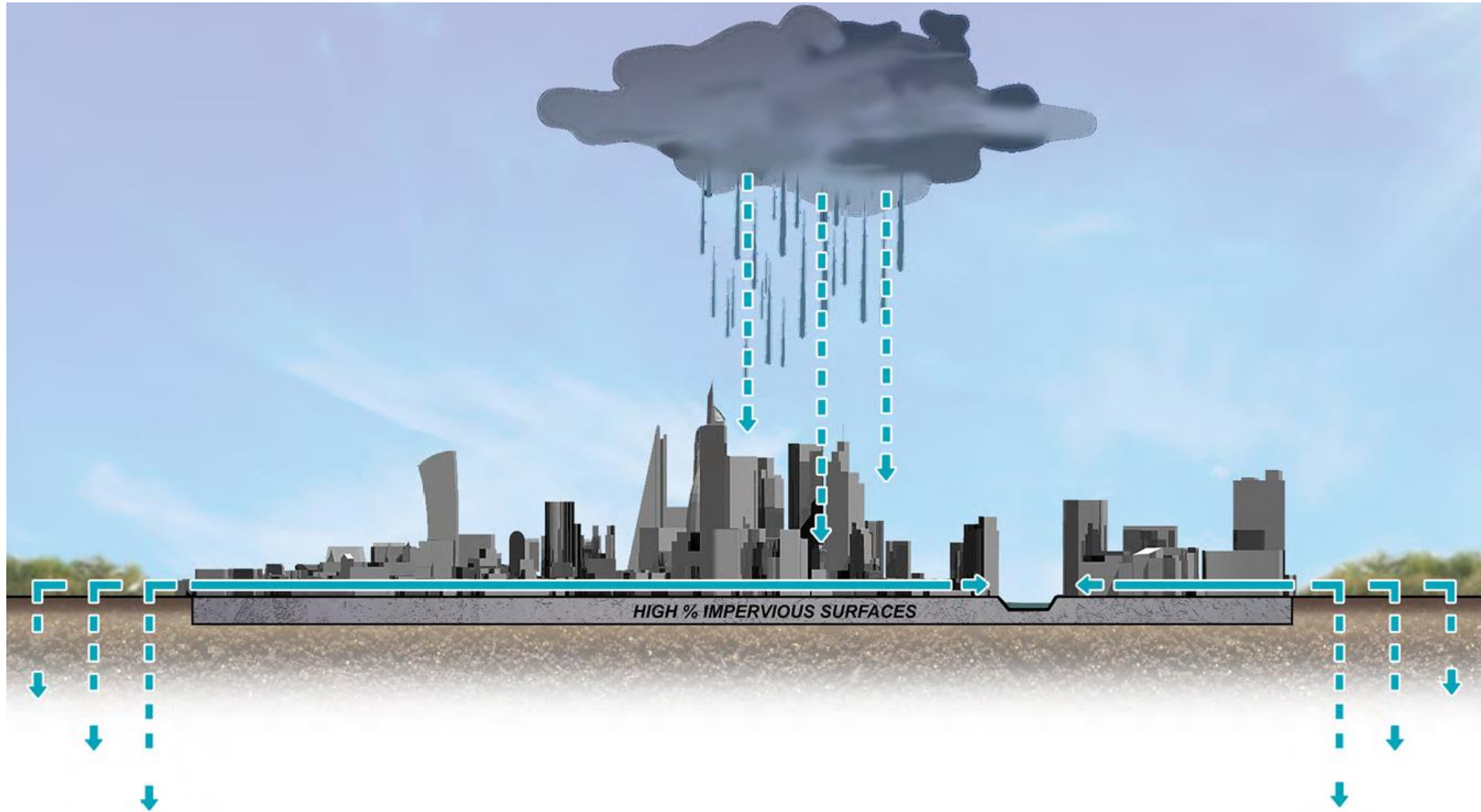

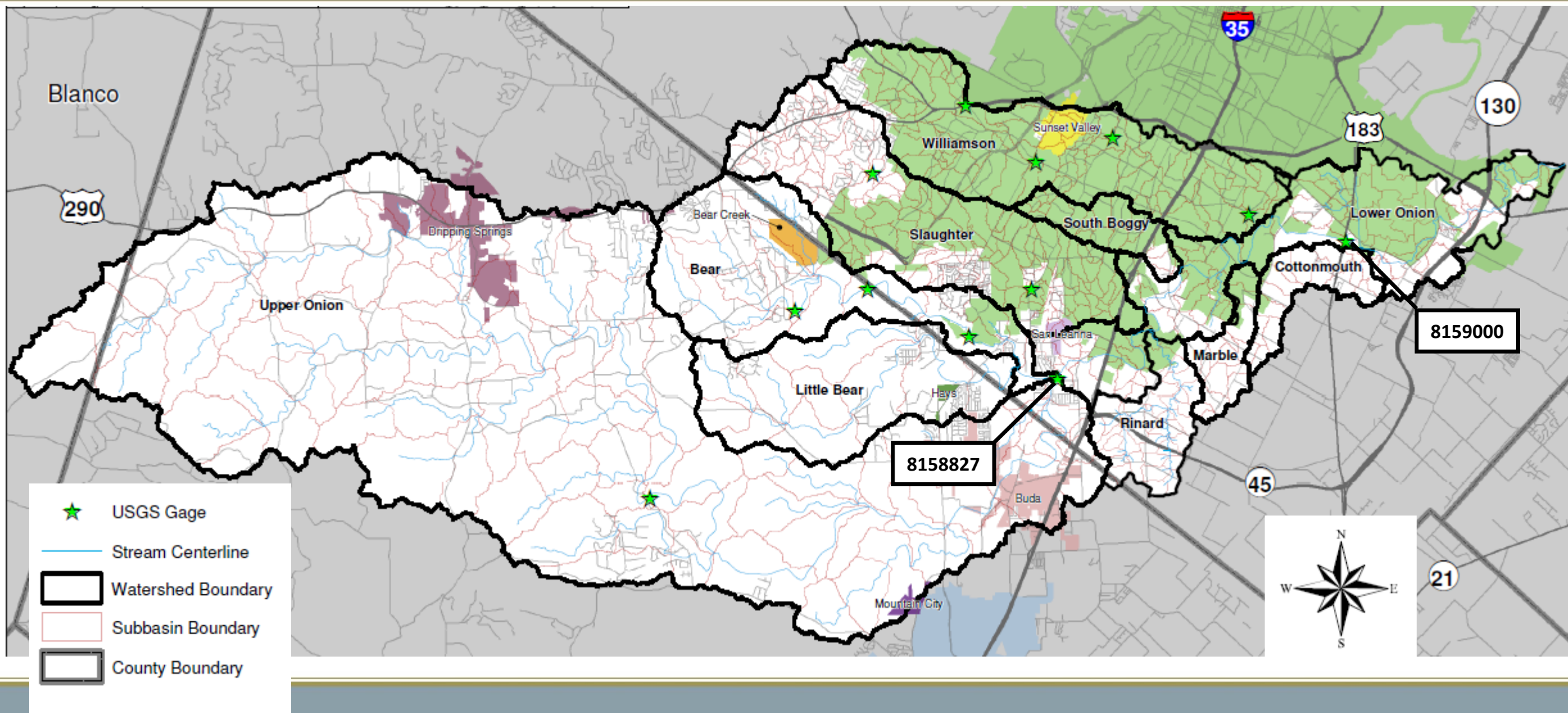


Hydrologic Cycle: Rain to Flow

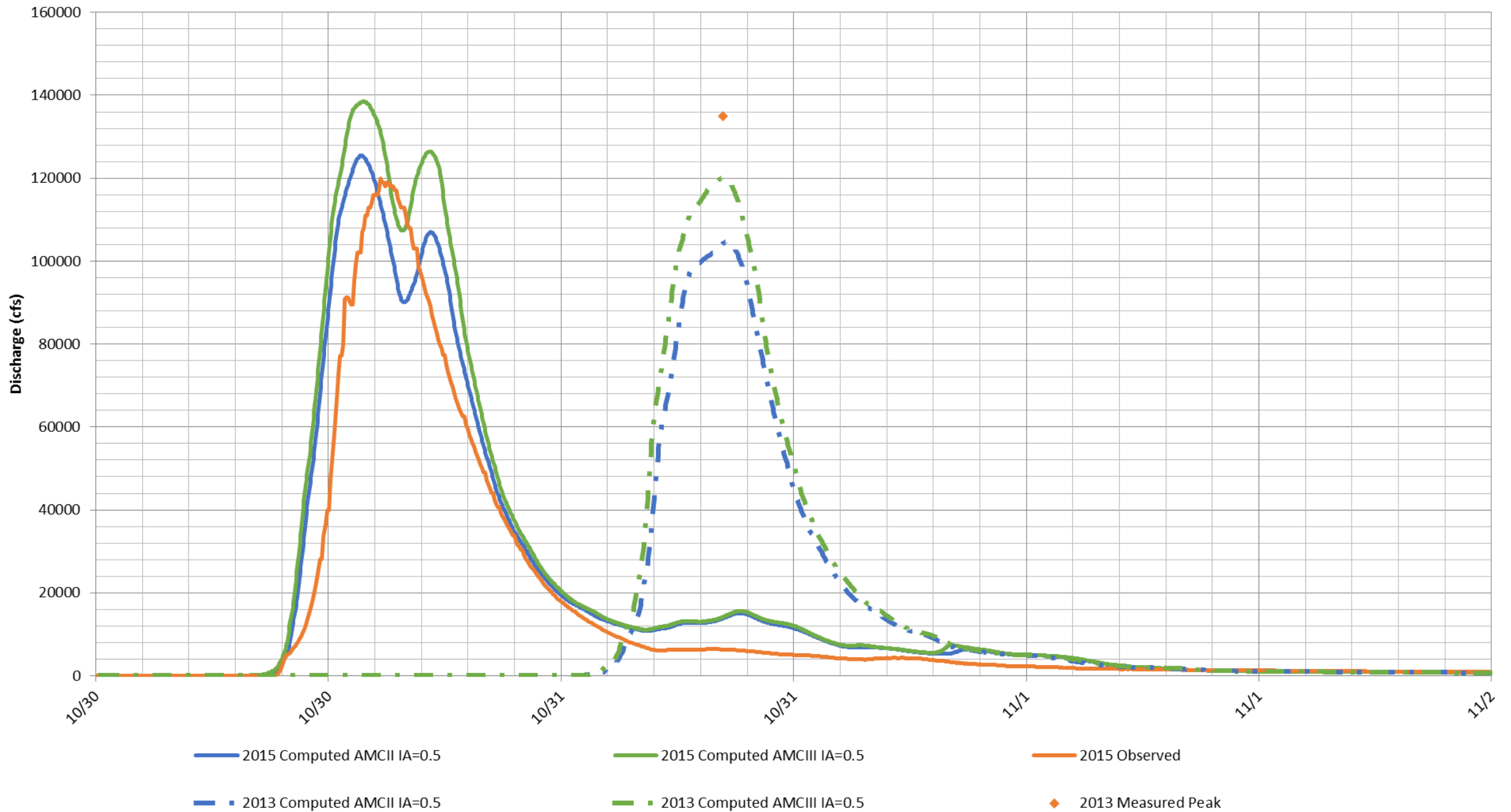




Onion Creek USGS Flow Gages

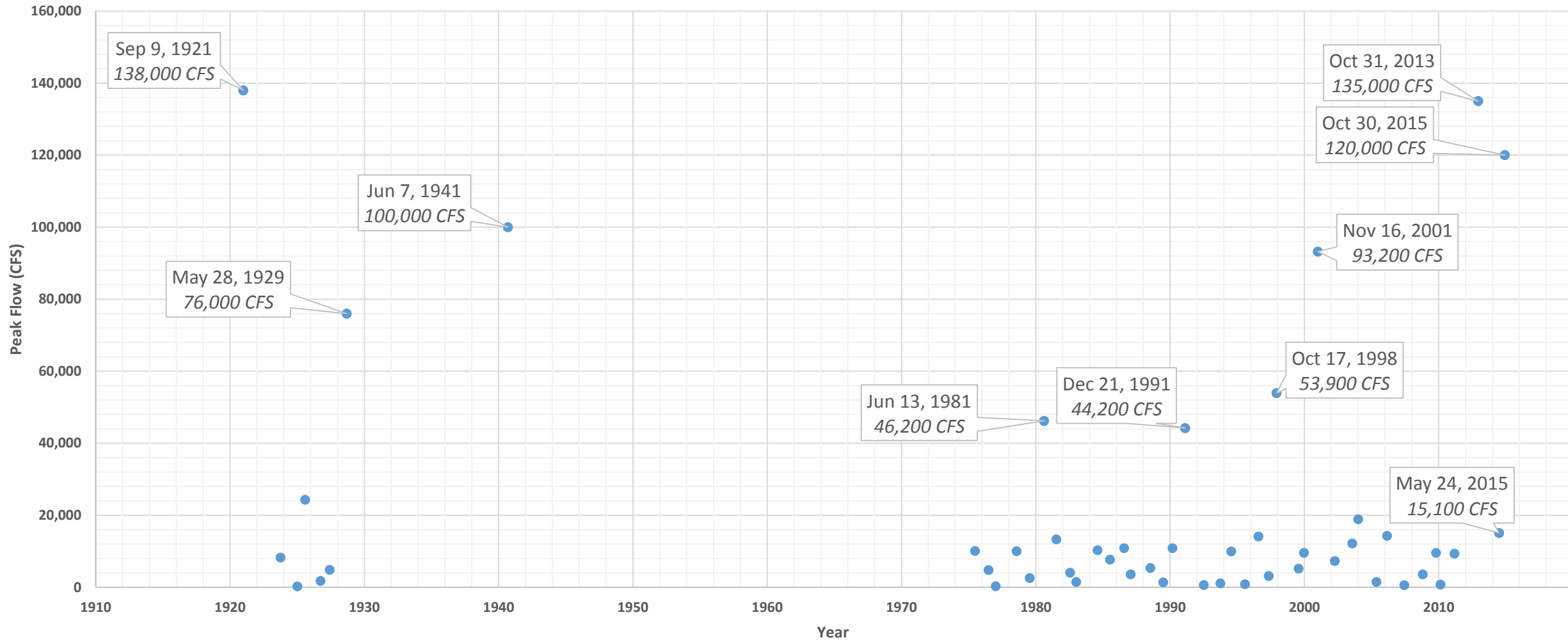

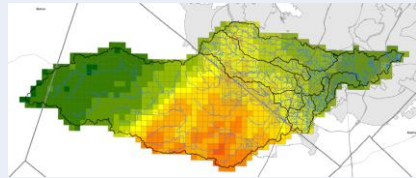
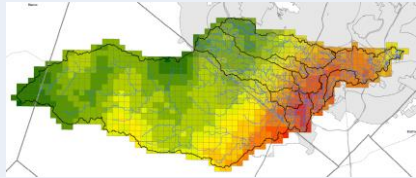


Probability of Flooding

Flood Events	Probability of Occurrence in ANY given year	Percent Chance of Occurrence in ANY given year
500 Year	1 in 500	0.2 %
100 Year	1 in 100	1 %
50 Year	1 in 50	2 %
10 Year	1 in 10	10 %
