2. Task Force ran the meeting. Discussion included:
 - a. Further review of Chapter 384, numerous changes proposed to the latest version of Chapter 384. Glenn will have an update to the team by Friday. David will send out to Travis County for review including legal, ROW, etc.
 - b. Documents and changes to Chapter 384 will need to go to a stakeholder public hearing. Timing is not clear.
 - c. Patrick may want a summary of Citizen Communications, Kathy will provide.
 - d. Graphics for the report or back up will be provided with assistance from TNR GIS. Kathy will get with GIS. Suggested an overall map and individual information on Short List projects similar to the CBAC graphics.
 - e. Recommendation to package areas together. Kathy will add this to the DRAFT short list.
 - f. Recommendation to not exceed approximately 4 miles of roads on the short list.
 - g. Kathy will send draft graphics to David which he might include with documents sent to Travis County team for review.
 - h. A road package in Cardinal Hills including Julie Lane might be appropriate. Kathy will review and add to DRAFT short list.
 - i. Other community areas were recommended for road package consideration including Lago Vista, Apache Shores, Deer Creek.
 - j. Task Force members may review Draft Report. Kathy went over some matrix columns with the Task Force. The range for some column items may not be broad enough.
 - k. Other conversations were had but not captured.
3. Goal to have documents completed and decisions made in two weeks.
